Dear Henry Larsen Families,

We hope everyone had a safe and wonderful winter break. Unfortunately, we are once again faced with challenging times in education, as Premier Ford announced today a move to remote learning for Ontario students for the next two weeks. The staff here at Henry Larsen are committed and creative educators who will work to create a remote learning environment to continue your child's high level of education. We know that this is not easy for families nor for students, but Henry Larsen students have shown us they can do it! Thank you for all that you do to support your children, especially moving into remote learning. We look forward to when we can return all together safely.

Access to Technology and/or Wifi:

If you require access to a Chromebook (please use the <u>linked Google Form</u>). The school has a limited number of devices available and may be able to lend one to you. If you do not have access to the internet because it is not available where you live, there are a small number of hotspots available. Please let us know if you need access to technology or wifi and we will do our best to accommodate your request.

Families should also prepare for remote learning by doing the following:

- Plan the day using the school day schedule and routine;
- Review instructions for signing in to the Google Classroom;
- Learn more about remote learning netiquette in English, French, Arabic; and
- Take some time to watch these videos about <u>Google Meet</u> (scroll down to the Google Meet section, under "Videos" in <u>English</u> and <u>Arabic</u>)

School Schedule:

 On Wednesday, January 5th, students and educators will follow the regular school timetable for start time, nutrition breaks and recess. Students will have a total of 300 minutes of learning

- time, some of that time will be teacher-led (synchronous) and some will be independent work on assigned tasks (asynchronous). Some subjects will take place asynchronously this week.
- The school day schedule is below. The teacher will provide more detailed information about the learning blocks, which subjects will be taught when, and when students will be learning online and when they will be working independently.

UPDATED Screening Tool and Verification:

Thank you for taking the time every morning to use the <u>screening tool</u>, we know it is challenging when we are busy getting ready for the day! It is very important to screen each person in your household every day for <u>symptoms</u>. If anyone in the household has any of the first group of symptoms (fever/chills, cough, shortness of breath, decrease/loss of smell and taste), or two of the second group of symptoms (sore throat, headache, fatigue, runny nose/nasal congestion, muscle aches/joint pain, GI symptoms vomiting/diarrhea), all household members need to isolate regardless of vaccination status.

Staff will be verifying that this screening has been completed with each student every day. Homeroom teachers will reach out to families with the method that they will be using for this daily confirmation (either a paper sent home each day, or an online Google form, or a verbal confirmation with grades 4-8 students).

Greetings Henry Larsen Families,

Today, your child has been provided with two take-home rapid antigen screening kits. The test kits were provided by the Government of Ontario, and are intended for use by any child that attends a publicly funded school, regardless of their vaccination status.

Please read the important information below prior to using the rapid antigen testing kit.

When to Use the Rapid Antigen Test Kit:

The Rapid Antigen Tests have been provided proactively and are to be used when:

- a student is exhibiting symptoms and is required to self isolate, or
- is a household contact of someone with symptoms and is required to self-isolate.
- Where an individual is <u>experiencing symptom(s)</u> and does not have access to a PCR test or RAT, the individual is presumed to have COVID-19 based on their symptoms.

Using the Take-Home Rapid Antigen Test Kit:

Please follow the instructions provided by the manufacturer and use the following resources:

- How to use Rapid Antigen Tests <u>Manufacturer's Instructions</u>.
- <u>Videos: Rapid antigen testing for asymptomatic students</u> (Available in multiple languages)
- Ottawa Public Health Frequently Asked Questions about Rapid Antigen Testing

Parents or guardians may choose to administer the test on children who may need help.

What to do after your test:

- If the student receives two negative results on tests taken at least 24 hours apart they may return to attending school as usual. Even if your child tests negative, they should continue to adhere to all relevant public health guidance, such as guidance on gathering, distancing, and masking.
- A positive result on a rapid antigen screening test is considered a preliminary positive and your child should self-isolate in accordance with these <u>guidelines</u>.

While providing students with rapid antigen test kits is an important tool for managing the spread of COVID-19, it is also important to remember that we all need to continue with key public health strategies that have been effective in keeping this pandemic under control, including staying home when sick, getting vaccinated, getting tested if you have symptoms, washing your hands frequently and wearing a face covering as required.

Thank you for your ongoing cooperation in following public health guidelines and helping to keep our school safe.


Hello Henry Larsen Families,
